ORDINANCE NO. 59-71

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

Sponsored by Councilman Victor Green on the 30th day of August, 1971

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 4-71
BY CHANGING THE PAY PERIODS FOR ALL EMPLOYEES
FROM THE FIRST AND FIFTEENTH OF EACH MONTH TO
FRIDAY OF EACH WEEK.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pay Periods.

That Section 3 "Pay Periods" of Ordinance 4-71 is hereby amended
as follows:

[All employees shall be paid semi-monthly.] All employees
shall be paid weekly on Friday of each week with the first
payment to be on August 13, 1971, for the period of August 2,
1971, through August 6, 1971, except that the Director of
Finance, Municipal Attorney and City Engineer shall be paid
at such times as may be designated by the City Manager.

Section 2.

Section 10 "Pay Period" of Ordinance 4-71 as follows, is hereby
repealed:

[The pay period for all employees listed herein shall be
from the first to the fifteenth and from the fifteenth to
the first of each month.]

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
ordinance and shall be effective upon passage. A public emergency affecting
public health, safety and general welfare is hereby declared to exist by
virtue of the fact that the providing for weekly pay periods for employees
will alleviate existing personnel problems and contribute to the orderly
running of the City government.
