ORDINANCE NO. 64-71 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

Sponsored by Councilman Russell Sweetman on the 30th day of August, 1971.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SETTING COMPENSATION FOR THE ACTING CITY MANAGER AS OF THE DATE OF HIS APPOINTMENT, JULY 1, 1971.

WHEREAS, James Smith was appointed acting City Manager on July 1, 1971, to serve until a permanent city manager's appointment has been made; and

WHEREAS, the duties of said James Smith as acting City Manager are in addition to his duties as Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that additional compensation should be paid to that City Manager for the additional duties and responsibilities appertaining to said position;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section 1. As of July 1, 1971, and for such period as he shall continue as acting City Manager of the City of Centerville, Ohio, James Smith shall be paid compensation, in additional to his present salary, in the amount of \$50.00 per month.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency and shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting the safety and general welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City of Centerville is presently without the services of a permanent City Manager and the interests of the City can best be served by providing additional compensation for the acting City Manager during the period of his tenure as acting City Manager.
