ORDINANCE NUMBER 88-71
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN RUSSELL SWEETMAN ON THE 20th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1971.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF MARSHA WAY TO MARSHA
JEANNE WAY.WHEREAS, it appears to Council that there are two streets in the
greater Dayton area with similar names, viz. Marsha Way and Marsha Lane, andWHEREAS, the two streets are in separate parts of the greater Dayton
area which would cause confusion to the citizens and difficulty in mail
delivery, andWHEREAS, a municipality has the power to change a street name without
a petition therefor by virtue of Section 723.05 Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section 1. That the name of "Marsha Way" as contained on a plat
known as Rose Estates, Section 1 located in Sections 29, and 35, Town 3, Range
5 M.R.S., City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, containing 14.984
acres, approved by this Council on the 5th day of April, 1971 and recorded in
Plat Book 90 Page 83 of the Plat Records of Montgomery County, Ohio is hereby
changed to "Marsha Jeanne Way".

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time
allowed by law.
