## ORDINANCE NO. 15-70

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE FIRE CHIEF OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT AS FIRE CHIEF AND FIRE PREVENTION OFFICER OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 737.21 Ohio Revised Code permits a municipality to establish all necessary regulations to guard against the occurrence of fires; and

WHEREAS, fire prevention is deemed essential in guarding against the occurrence of fires;

NOW, THEREFORE

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Fire Chief of the Washington Township is hereby appointed as Fire Chief and Fire Prevention Officer for the City of Centerville to serve indefinitely and until his successor is qualified and appointed.

Section 2. The duties of the Fire Chief and the Fire Prevention Officer shall be those outlined in Sections 737.09, 737.21 and 737.22 O.R.C. and such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Director of the Department of Safety.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting health, safety and the public welfare is hereby declared to exist because the citizens of Centerville are presently without a Fire Chief and Fire Prevention Officer to enforce Centerville's regulations to guard against the occurrence of fires in the City.
