ORDINANCE NUMBER 39-70

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 7-70 OF FEBRUARY 16, 1970, FOR A TABLE OF ORGANIZATION, PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATIONS, RATES OF PAY, AND REGULATIONS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 1, B. of Ordinance 7-70 passed February 16, 1970 shall be amended as follows:

B. Department of Public Safety - Division of Police.

SECTION 2. That Section 2, E. of Ordinance 7-70, passed February 16, 1970 shall be amended as follows:

E. Street Superintendent [\$9,300.00] \$10,000.00

SECTION 3. That Section 4, c. of Ordinance 7-70, passed February 16, 1970 shall be amended as follows:

c. Subject to satisfactory efficiency ratings, [the members of the Police Department shall attain the next grade upon completion of one (1) year of service and an additional grade upon completion of each year of satisfactory service thereafter until the maximum pay grade listed opposite their title in Section 1 shall have been achieved] City employees, including the positions of Secretary, Clerk-Typist, Police Dispatcher, Street Foreman, Utility Man and Building Inspector, may attain the next step upon completion of six (6) months probationary period, and Police Patrolmen and Police Sergeants may attain the next step upon completion of twelve (12) months probationary period. Subsequent step rates shall be based on merit for all employees.

SECTION 4. The amended compensation provided for herein shall be retroactive to, and become effective as follows:

Police Sergeant II	June 1, 1970
The fourth or additional Police Patrolmen III	June 1, 1970
Street Superintendent	June 1, 1970

SECTION 5. All Ordinances, resolutions or memorandums, or parts of same, inconsistent herewith shall be repealed, and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
