ORDINANCE NO. 48-70

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15-61, THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, KNOWN AS "THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, 1961".

WHEREAS, for the purpose of regulating, restricting, and limiting in the interest of public health, safety, and convenience, comfort, prosperity, and the general welfare, the uses and locations of buildings, and other structures and premises to be used as shown herein, the height, bulk, and location of buildings and other structures, hereafter erected or altered, including minimum lot areas, set-back building lines, and the area of yards, courts, and other open spaces, said restrictions being best suited to carry out the purposes, and to provide fees for the administration of the Zoning Ordinance.
