ORDINANCE NO. 51-70

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2-70 OF JANUARY 19, 1970 AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 7-70 OF FEBRUARY 16, 1970 FOR A TABLE OF ORGANIZATION, PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATIONS, RATES OF PAY, AND REGULATIONS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 7-70 is hereby amended to read as follows, with the portions repealed in brackets and the new portions underlined:

C. Department of Service - Division of Refuse Collection

<u>6</u>	<u>Groundmen</u>	<u>8C</u>

SECTION 2. That Section 9 of Ordinance 7-70 is hereby amended to read as follows, with the portions repealed in brackets and the new portions underlined:

SECTION 9.
The compensation provided for herein shall be retroactive to, and become effective on the first day of January, 1970. Compensation provided herein for Refuse Collection employees shall become effective October 26, 1970.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting health, safety, and the public welfare is hereby declared to exist on the basis that it is necessary to revise the table of organization, classifications, rates of pay and personnel regulations at once in order to preserve the operating efficiency and morale of the Department of Service, Division of Refuse Collection.
