ORDINANCE No. 29-69

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF EAST VILLAGE ROAD TO ROLLING OAK DRIVE.

WHEREAS, it appears to Council that there are two streets in the Municipality with similar names, viz North and South Village Drive and East Village Road, and;

WHEREAS, the two streets are in separate parts of the municipality which could cause confusion to the citizens, and;

WHEREAS, a municipality has the power to change a street name without a petition therefor by virtue of §723.05 Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section 1. That the name of "East Village Road" as contained on a plat (known as Connective Plat-Record Plan only affecting Lots Numbered 214, 215, 236, 237 and 238 of Black Oak Estates - Two, Section One located in Sections 13 and 19, T-2, R-6 MRS, Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, containing 26.803 Acres) approved by this Council on the 22nd day of July, 1968 and recorded in Plat Book 84, pages 7 and 8 of the Plat Records of Montgomery County, Ohio, is hereby changed to "Rolling Oak Drive."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
