ORDINANCE NO. 30-69

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A WRITTEN CONTRACT WITH S-K CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR ROAD WORK TO BE PERFORMED ON EAST FRANKLIN STREET IN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the direction of Council the City Manager advertised for bids for road work on East Franklin Street in the City, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter and the Ohio Revised Code, and;

WHEREAS, S-K Construction Company has submitted the lowest and best bid and has complied with the bidding procedure, including the furnishing of a 5% bid bond;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract for road work on East Franklin Street in the City in accordance with the terms of the Proposal of S-K Construction Company a copy of which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting the public health, safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist because of the immediate need for street reconstruction for portions of East Franklin Street, to provide safety for motorists using this main thoroughfare in the City of Centerville.
