ORDINANCE NO. 34-69

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 13-69, AN
ORDINANCE DEFINING PROCEDURE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 1 (B) of said Ordinance No. 13-69 is hereby
amended as follows:

"When an expenditure for any purpose mentioned in sub-
section (A) herein exceeds One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
(\$1,500.00), the Council shall, by ordinance or resolution,
authorize and direct the City Manager to make such expenditure,
take bids and make and execute all necessary contracts according
to the procedure hereafter set forth."

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public
emergency affecting health, safety and the public welfare is hereby declared
to exist because several contracts for the City are proposed and the execution
of said contracts at the earliest possible date is essential.
