ORDINANCE NO. 38-69

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 25-69 AND TO ESTABLISH TERMS FOR SAID APPOINTEES.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. In accordance with the terms of Ordinance No. 25-69 the Council hereby appoints the following members to serve on the City Planning Commission for the terms set forth opposite their names:

- 1. Harold Wells to serve for a term of two years, commencing June 5, 1969, but not to exceed his term of office on the Council of the City of Center ville.
- 2. Hugh Lage drost to serve for a term of four years, commencing June 5, 1969.
- 3. Nevin Elliott to serve for a term of four years, commencing June 5, 1969.
- 4. Elmer C. Tate to serve for a term of four years, commencing June 5, 1969.
- 5 John Mann Butler to serve for a term of two years, commencing June 5, 1969.
- 6. Willis B. Creamer to serve for a term of two years, commencing June 5, 1969.
- 7. Bruce H. Baker to serve for a term of two years, commencing June 5, 1969.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting health, safety and the public welfare is hereby declared to exist because of the fact that the City of Centerville is presently without a City Planning Commission and the appointment of members to serve thereon at the earliest possible date is essential in order that cases now pending may be processed.
