Mayor Compton called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Councilmembers discussed a letter received regarding the parole hearing for Mr. Todd Snyder – CRCA262-474, a 1992 convicted rapist, the victim a Centerville resident.

Public Works Director Doug Spitler showed an example of the signs being erected for bike path route #12 which are being placed on the east/west bike path throughout Centerville. These signs are being installed with the cooperation of Washington Township and the City of Bellbrook.

Mr. Spitler updated Council on the work of a consultant assisting with providing guidance for the signalization at State Route 48 and Spring Valley.
