Mayor Compton called the meeting to order at 6:35 P.M.

In City Manager/City Council Communications, Mr. Davis shared information on the following topics:

- The Ohio Police tentative agreement
- The meeting with Sugarcreek Township regarding Brown Road
- The commendation of Finance Director Jonathan Hudson for CAFR completion

Mr. Palcher inquired about the status and plans for the Elsa's property on Far Hills Avenue where buildings were taken down. Staff will put together an update.

Mayor Compton introduced a discussion about parking on Glencroft Drive and the complaints received from residents. "No Parking" signs were originally put up to keep high school students from parking on the street.

Mr. Brinegar reviewed the State Route 725 Urban Paving Program and the Crack Sealing Program. The single bid received for the crack sealing program was reasonable.

At approximately 7:05 P.M. Mr. Engert arrived at the meeting and Mr. Palcher made a motion to move into Executive Session for Economic Development, for Collective



Bargaining updates concerning compensation or other terms and conditions of employment and for Litigation to confer with the municipal attorney on pending or imminent litigation. Mrs. Rau seconded the motion, and it passed with a 7-0 vote. After no official business was conducted, Mrs. Kenley made a motion to move out of Executive Session, which was seconded by Mrs. Rau and passed with a 7-0 vote.

When Mayor Compton adjourned the meeting at 7:25 P.M., Council moved to Council Chambers for the regular Council meeting. The next work session will be Monday, June 4, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. in the Law Library.
