The meeting began at 6:30 P.M. Mr. Horn shared information on a number of topics related to the bicycle committee, including a recent meeting, road widths, bike paths and the installation of bicycle racks. Mr. Beals inquired about the availability of funds from the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission, and Mr. Spitler confirmed a \$250,000 commitment from MVRPC for bicycle projects.

Mr. Horn received a letter from Ms. Carol Otte – 655 Legendary Way regarding the ditch area by hole #7 at Yankee Trace that has been designated as a wetlands area, asking for approval to trim invasive plants.

Mrs. Kenley made a motion to convene into Executive Session for personnel. Mrs. Rau seconded the motion. The vote resulted in 7 ayes. After no official business was conducted, Mrs. Kenley made a motion to move out of Executive Session, and it was seconded by Mr. Engert. The motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

A brief discussion regarding items on Consent Agenda for the regular meeting followed, before the Mayor adjourned the meeting at approximately 7:30 P.M. Council moved to Council Chambers for the regular meeting.
