Mrs. Andrews received an email from Patti Meszaro, Director Facility Planning/Construction for Premier Health Miami Valley Hospital South regarding Case P-2017-0014, the Appeal of the Decision of the Planning Commission. The appeal specifies Condition #2 in the approval of the Major Site Plan for a new bed tower for Miami Valley Hospital South. The communication addressed to the Clerk of Council expressed the applicants' wishes to voluntarily table the appeal on this evening's agenda until the May meeting of Council.

Mr. Horn updated Council on a recent meeting with Joann Ringer, Chief Operating Officer for Miami Valley Hospital South. Staff discussed the phased improvements that have been made to Wilmington Pike and Clyo Road, the amounts the hospital has contributed, and future planned projects. A Traffic Impact Study was done in 2005 and updated in 2010. The amount of traffic coming from the hospital, the increased volume with the addition, and how that affects the Wilmington Pike/Clyo Road intersection were discussed.

Agenda items for this evening's meeting were reviewed.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:25 P.M. and Council moved to Council Chambers for the regular meeting.
