
Councilmembers met at 6:00 p.m. in the Law Library. Mr. Beals made a motion to adjourn into Executive Session for Personnel and Litigation in order to discuss the appointment, employment or compensation of public officials or public employees and to consult with the Municipal Attorney concerning pending court action. Mr. Palcher seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes. About 6:50 p.m., staff members entered for the discussion of pending court action. After no official business was conducted, Mr. Palcher made a motion to adjourn out of Executive Session. Mrs. Rau seconded the motion. A roll call vote showed the motion passed 7-0.

Council and staff organized general items for the monthly meeting that followed. Council agreed Mr. Norman Plair and Mr. Bryce Nickel should be reappointed for three years to their respective Personnel Appeals Board positions. Staff announced the receipt of an email from Mr. Raj Grandhi requesting Council table consideration of his application for a Preliminary Development Plan for the Villas of Centerville at Chardonnay Drive to the Council meeting on March 21, 2016. The same application had been tabled at the November meeting. Mr. Horn asked Mr. Liberman to give a brief report during the regular meeting concerning the Supreme Court case on the Sugarcreek Township fire district.
