The meeting began about 6:30 P.M. The Mayor, Council and staff reviewed agenda items for the regular meeting to follow. A discussion was held about Items C. and D. on the Consent Agenda, the settlement agreement with Sugarcreek Township and the Fire/EMS agreement.

At approximately 6:45 P.M., Mr. Palcher made a motion to convene into Executive Session to consult with the City Attorney regarding pending court action. Mrs. Kenley seconded the motion. The vote resulted in 7 ayes. Mr. Cahall left the meeting at approximately 7:00 P.M. After no official business was conducted, Mrs. Kenley made a motion to adjourn out of Executive Session at approximately 7:25 P.M. Mrs. Rau seconded the motion. The motion passed 7-0.

Council concurred to reconvene the work session after the regular meeting. Mayor Compton recessed the meeting at 7:30 P.M. and the group moved to Council Chambers.

Council returned to the Law Library to continue the work session meeting at 9:20 P.M. Staff members Andrew Rodney, Kristen Gopman and Jennifer Wilder were dismissed from this portion of the meeting.

Jim Brinegar reviewed a proposed cooperative project with the City of Kettering to construct a section of bike trail on Hewitt Road, in lieu of the connector that has been discussed for over/under I-675. This hiker/biker extension would be a 2020-2021 Capital Improvement Program project and would include a grant request to MVRPC for Transportation Alternative

(TA) funds. Council concurred this link could be a good solution to providing a desired connector between trails north and south of I-675.

At approximately 9:35 P.M., Mr. Engert made a motion to convene into Executive Session to consult with the City Attorney regarding pending court action. Mr. Beals seconded the motion. The vote resulted in 7 ayes. After no official business was conducted, Mrs. Rau made a motion to adjourn out of Executive Session at approximately 11:10 P.M., Mr. Engert seconded the motion. The motion passed 7-0.

Mayor Compton called for a work session meeting to be held on Wednesday, September 21 at 5:30 P.M. in the Law Library. The work session meeting was adjourned at 11:12 P.M.
