Mr. Rodney reminded the members of Council that, at the meeting on May 18, 2015, they approved a revised record plat for property located at 6775-6883 Wilmington Pike for construction of a Montessori School. As a condition of approval, a License Agreement was to be entered into between the Applicant, Karen Lampe, and the City to permit the private use of excess public right-of-way for the proposed driveway connection to White's Corner. This agreement was to be signed prior to final approval of the record plan. Mr. Liberman explained that Ms. Lampe's attorney requested an easement rather than a License Agreement.
