Mr. Horn shared information regarding a couple of residents with hardship issues related to the trimming and removal of dead trees. Mr. Sande Heck worked with a resident on Tuxworth Avenue to have an arborist evaluate a tree. It appears that the tree will be fine with trimming. A resident near Spring Valley Road had 3 or 4 ash trees to be removed at a \$3,000-4,000 cost. The resident requested help in removal of the trees. The City drafted an agreement with the property owner whereby the City would cut the trees. The property owner would be responsible for cleaning up the brush within 30 days. The owner would agree to allow the cost of the work to be assessed, certified to the County Auditor, and then added to the tax duplicate until the house was sold. Council concurred to move forward.

Mr. Compton briefed Council regarding complaints concerning noise at the high school. A petition had been circulated around the neighborhood. Dr. Henderson was unaware of any new events, but he said he would check with the Athletic Director.

Mr. Horn noted the United Way of Greater Dayton had received grant funding for the SeniorLink program. Council passed a resolution in August of this year agreeing to participate as a pilot city and to commit funds not to exceed \$5,000.

Mr. Horn updated Council on the Together Dayton initiative.

A letter had been drafted to the Washington Township Trustees with regard to dispatch services.
