Discussion was held regarding a signage issue. At the December 2015 meeting, the Planning Commission tabled action on three variances needed by Miami Valley Hospital South for a large ground sign that would be visible along I-675. Mr. Horn stated Joann Ringer of Miami Valley and several others were meeting with staff at the Municipal Building the next day. Mr. Rodney said he was hopeful of finding common ground. This issue brought attention to conversations from the past concerning the possible need to revise the sign code, because of the number of properties with wider street frontages. It was suggested to add signage to the Council Retreat items.
