Mr. Horn reviewed the following items on the Consent Agenda for the Council Meeting:


- the resolution accepting the Amounts and Rates as Determined by the Budget Commission
- the resolution accepting the salt bid from Cargill, Inc. with an 88% increase in price over last year
- the resolution accepting the bid from John R. Jurgensen for the 2014 Citywide Asphalt Pavement Repairs
- the resolution accepting the bid from Brumbaugh Construction, Inc. for the North Village Drive access at Woodbourne Library

Mr. Horn noted that an ordinance was on the agenda to amend appropriations by \$70,145 for start-up costs associated with the creation of a Mayor's Court in 2015. It was still uncertain whether Kettering Courts might make a counteroffer on expenses to deter the City from moving forward. The ordinance was tabled at the August 18 Council Meeting to allow for more information to be compiled. Since then, Council had concurred to move forward.

Mr. Horn advised that a ribbon cutting for Costco Wholesale was being planned for November 12 or 13. He said he would inform Council of updates.
