
It was suggested to appoint Ms. Kathy Jablinski to the Arts Commission and that she could be sworn in at the November Council Meeting. She will be added to the Consent Agenda at the following Council Meeting.

Mr. Horn reviewed the Consent Agenda items for the following Council Meeting.

Mr. Horn gave an update on impending changes to Hole #7 of the Vintage Golf Course which was discussed earlier in the summer. The hole involves a small wetlands area, a stream and a bridge. It was felt that removing the bridge would reduce maintenance costs and allow for better alignment of the cart path. The city received approval from the Army Corps of Engineers to remove the bridge, install underdrain and fill in the ditch that connects the wetlands to the pond (as long as the change impacted less than 300 feet of wetlands). At this point, work on the bridge will be postponed until spring. Public Works crews and Yankee Trace crews are expected to cooperate to do the majority of the work.
