Council had some questions with regard to items on the agenda for the Council meeting following this Work Session. Mr. Feverston briefed Council on the Preliminary Development Plan for Cornerstone North. He specifically explained that Mr. Oberer had asked the Planning Commission to table for six months a rezoning of two areas totaling about 14.9 acres in the northeast section of Cornerstone North (Sub Area F) from B-PD with a Community Center Overlay (CC) to R-PD with a Neighborhood Residential Overlay (NR), zone classification. The request would increase the size of the residential area and create buffering challenges where the residential zone abuts large commercial retail stores. The Planning Commission is looking to Council for direction on this issue. Because the rezoning would increase the number of residential units that could be built in the quadrant, clarity is needed. If the Preliminary Development Plan is approved, the applicant will be preparing a Final Development Plan(s), Record Plats, and Site Plans for review by the Planning Commission and Council.

Mrs. Kenley made a motion to convene into Executive Session regarding Litigation. Mr. Cline seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes. At such time, after no
