Ms. Gopman noted that the enhancements to the Veterans Memorial are to be dedicated during the Veterans Day Ceremony on Monday, November 11 at 11:00 a.m. A request was made to Dodd's Monument by Mrs. Virginia Hess, the artist, to have two small plaques attached to the bas reliefs in memory of two individuals for their military service. Mr. Vitali from the local Veterans Group noted that the Memorial is to honor all veterans, and it would be a breach of protocol to the other members of the service to individually recognize two individuals. Mrs. James will contact Ms. Hess and ask her to come in to meet with Mayor Kingseed on November 5 to discuss this matter.

Mrs. Kenley made a motion to convene into Executive Session regarding Economic Development and Litigation. Mr. Cline seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes. The Council discussed information regarding litigation with Sugarcreek Township and regarding confidential negotiations related to economic assistance for public infrastructure improvements for the Cornerstone project. Mr. Gresham seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes.
