Mr. Horn briefed Council on the following topics:

Oakwood, Kettering, and Centerville had filed an application for a Local Government Innovative Grant. The grant has been approved for the purpose of developing and operating a fiber optic system connecting the existing fiber optics owned by the three governmental entities.

Centerville has recently received several awards from the Miami Valley Risk Management Association. Centerville has been a member of MVRMA for ten years and have ranked the third highest of all 20 communities.

- The Centerville Police Department was recognized for 100 percent compliance for Best Practices in Law Enforcement.
- Centerville was given a 100 percent rating for its annual Safety Performance Evaluation assessment.

The insurance pool has paid off very well for the City. We are heading into the second decade using the risk management approach.

Centerville was recognized by the Miami Valley Communications Council with the 2013 Exceptional Commitment to Employee Training and Safety Award.
