The City just received word that the State awarded a \$15,000 grant for removal and replacement of Ash trees in Yankee Trace and Stubbs Park. The Ohio Department of Natural Resources grant is very timely in that Mr. Terry Taylor, Maintenance Superintendent, has said the Emerald Ash Borer has hit Yankee Trace. The golf course will be losing a lot of trees over the next couple of years. The City will lose trees throughout the area and staff has been looking at 18 possible tree species for replacement. A variety of trees will be used as replacements.


The Montgomery County Solid Waste Management District has asked for a Resolution for renewal of their Solid Waste Management Plan. The Resolution is under the Consent Agenda.
