

Captain Mark Casey and Deputy-Chief Jim Neidhard were present to give an update on the 2012 Centerville-Washington Township Disaster Plan. Captain Casey explained that a Resolution will be on the November 19 Council Meeting Agenda to approve the revised Joint Emergency Operations Plan between the City of Centerville and Washington Township. He gave a history of the Emergency Operations Plan which was first adopted by both entities in 1999 and went over the revisions with regard to staffing, roles and responsibilities of Council and Staff. On December 19 the Police Department Training Room will be set up for a joint exercise from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. A reminder notice will be put in Council's packet.

Mr. Horn and Dr. Hinshaw continued to outline the proposed Capital Improvement Program for 2013-2017 from the previous Work Session meeting. The city has tried to position itself for the drastic cuts that have and are occurring from the State level. A major goal is debt retirement for the Yankee Trace Golf Course. After Council finished the review of the CIP they began the review of the Operating Budget. Council will continue to review the Budget at the November 12 Council Work Session.

Mayor Kingseed asked everyone to look at their calendars for the Council Retreat and to get back with Mrs. James with regard to their availability at the end of January and beginning of February.
