Mayor Compton called the meeting to order at 6:35 P.M.

Speedway/Wilmington Pike Rezoning

Mr. Yandrick provided a background of the project site, currently zoned O-S, and an explanation of Planning Commission's denial of the request to rezone to B-2, which was defeated 0-6 due to concerns with that zoning's land use and landscape screening requirements. Mr. Yandrick indicated Staff is supportive of the rezoning which is set for Public Hearing at the March 16, 2020 Council meeting.

Mr. Yandrick introduced Mr. Sweet and Mr. Duffy. Mr. Sweet presented preliminary plan concepts including elevations and an anticipated 50 foot buffer zone between the site and Whipp Court. The project is slated for the 2023-24 timeframe. The project will add five gas pumps, enlarge the three existing tanks, and update the existing gas station facility, bringing it to a level of character consistent with the Cornerstone Development. Mr. Sweet noted a similarly updated facility is located in Beavercreek on Indian Ripple at Darst if Councilmembers would like to see an example.

Kettering Boundary Adjustment

Mr. Yandrick advised the Ordinance for the Boundary Adjustment is on the Consent Agenda tonight to be set for Public Hearing on March 16, 2020. The other item, transfer of ownership of the park property is pending due to a "reverter" clause. Once that is addressed, it will move forward for Council action. Staff is maintaining communications with the affected property owners.

Retreat Debrief

Mayor Compton expressed appreciation for Staff's time and preparation for the Retreat. Council commended the meeting format, acknowledging a lot was accomplished in a short amount of time. Council discussed whether there was a need for a City retire/rehire policy. Council discussed interaction between Councilmembers and Staff, reminding to always include Mr. Davis in communications.
