

Mr. Horn gave background on Internet/Sweepstakes Cafes, a growing phenomenon in northern Ohio. Several local municipalities have been contacted as possible sites. A six-month moratorium on related permits would give the City time to research the issue, see case results related to the gambling component of the establishments and formulate any needed legislation. Council concurred to the moratorium. A resolution will be on the consent agenda.

Mr. Horn noted that Madeline Williams of MSA, the consultant who studied the Dille house in order to make a recommendation concerning landmark status, was expected to be in attendance at the Council Meeting for the public hearing. He stated that the group had not found any significant biographical information in doing additional research on Charles Dille to merit the house being a historical landmark.

Mr. Singer reported a vacancy on the Stormwater Drainage Task Force. He asked for names to be submitted by Council and staff as suggestions for a new member.

Mayor Kingseed asked that any additional retreat topics be submitted as soon as possible.
