
Mr. Merrill Durig was interviewed for the Stormwater Drainage Task Force. There are two other applicants to be interviewed at a Work Session meeting in September. A decision will be made at that time. The task force will not be meeting until the end of October.

Mr. Singer asked that Item F from the Consent Agenda be removed to New Business at the following Council Meeting. The item in particular is *A Resolution Imposing A Moratorium For A Period Of Six Months (180 Days) On The Granting Of Any Permit For An Alternative Energy System, Including A Solar Energy System, Within The City Of Centerville*. Mr. Singer's concern is that the Public Hearing for Mr. Tarazano's Appeal be heard before action is taken on the moratorium.

Mr. Horn reported that staff is recommending a three-year extension for the School Resource Officer Agreement with the Centerville City Schools. The City provides two officers – one for the high school and one for the middle schools. The school covers the cost of wages and benefits for one officer and the City takes care of the other and related expenses. A Resolution is on the Agenda for the Council Meeting following this work session.

Councilmembers will meet for a Council golf outing which is scheduled for Monday, August 22 at 4:30 p.m. at Yankee Trace. Council will then stay for dinner afterwards for *Neighbors Night* from 5-9 p.m. at The Gallery which will be offering a special dinner menu. Table service is being offered for both patio and restaurant dining instead of counter service.

It was suggested that the Council Work Session on September 12 start at 6:00 or 6:30 p.m. in order to begin the budgeting process. The City is initiating the budgeting process earlier than usual because of the state budget cutbacks and the challenging economic times.
