

Council will sponsor a table for ten at the Washington-Centerville Library's 200th Birthday Celebration that the Library is hosting on Friday, December 10, 2010 at Yankee Trace.

It was requested that Mr. Feverston look into the possibility of landmark status on a home in Centerville.

Mr. Compton informed Council that he had spoken with Mr. Dale Berry, Trustee. Mr. Berry stated that he had suggested to the Washington Township Trustees that the Township should pay one half of the City's portion of the project for Sheehan Road. This would be a reimbursement of part of the .7 mil money the City must send to Washington Township annually. It is hoped that Sheehan Road improvements can be considered a joint project that will benefit both Centerville and Washington Township residents.
