Mr. Yandrick presented to Council an information session regarding the geographic information system (GIS). GIS software mapping presents data, integrates, analyzes, shares and displays geographic information. GIS applications are tools that allow users to analyze information and presents results.

Mr. Singer entered the meeting at this time.

Mr. Yandrick went on to explain how geographic information can be utilized in different departments within the City. He shared the different projects he has worked on and the goals for the future. A new street map has been added to the City's website for citizens to access.

Mr. Horn reported that he had received a phone call from Mr. Rosenwald, a representative of the Black Equity Group, the developer that owns the Elder Beerman site, regarding the proposed Kroger Marketplace. Mr. Rosenwald told Mr. Horn that the Black Equity Group had recently had a productive meeting with Kroger representatives. Mr. Horn is concerned that the engineering firm should have started on the surveying a couple of weeks ago. The continued delays could cause the City to lose the OPWC grant funding for the Sheehan Road widening project. He will keep Council informed.

Mr. Compton made a motion to convene into Executive Session regarding Litigation and Personnel. Mr. Cline seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes. At such time, after no official business was conducted, Dr. Gresham moved that Council adjourn out of Executive Session. Mrs. Kenley seconded the motion.
