Mr. Horn explained in more detail the Resolution related to the right of way for the extension of Clyo Road that is on the Agenda at the Council Meeting following the Work Session. The Resolution would authorize the City Manager to sign two agreements after the conditions of the Resolution are met. The agreement with Sugarcreek Township would grant the road right of way for Clyo Road; the Township would consent not to appeal the two annexations of the Dille property. The second agreement is with Greene County whereby the City would deliver the right of way permit after the appeal time had passed and an appeal of the two annexations had not been filed.

Mr. Horn was asked if there were any issues regarding the Major Use Special Approval application by the St. Leonard Senior Living Community. There is one minor issue regarding an ornamental fence. It is getting worked out, and they are working with Staff.

Mr. Horn announced that a joint meeting is scheduled with the Washington Township Trustees on Monday, April 13, 2009. Also, the Mayor's Faith Leaders Breakfast is scheduled for Wednesday, March 25, 2009 at 8:00 a.m.

The anticipated date is April 2, 2009 regarding the confirmation of funding for the federal economic stimulus projects. The City has submitted four projects to MVRPC for possible

transportation funding. Two of the projects involve complete repainting of the bridges over I-675 at State Route 48 and Bigger Road, and the other two projects are major resurfacing projects.
