Mr. Spitler reviewed an agreement for the proposed traffic signal at the East Spring Valley Pike and Atchison Road intersection. The Agreement is between Montgomery County, Washington Township and the City of Centerville. The construction cost for the entire project is estimated to be \$117,730.00. Washington Township has agreed to pay the additional cost needed to upgrade the traffic signal from a span wire to a mast arm installation. Mrs. Lienesch asked Staff to provide accident statistics for both intersections of Cloy and Spring Valley and Atchison and Spring Valley Roads.

Mr. Horn mentioned that Chief Ken Parks will be at the February 19<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting to present the Washington Township Fire Department's Strategic Plan. The Strategic Plan is part of the Fire Department's accreditation process. Mr. Singer asked that Council receive a copy of the report in Friday's Council packets.

Mr. Spitler reviewed a color-coded map for the proposed intersection improvement at

Alex-Bell and State Route 48. This project is scheduled to begin in April 2008 with widening and the signalization to be completed in late summer of 2008.
