Mr. Cline made a motion to convene into Executive Session regarding Personnel and Litigation. Dr. Gresham seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.

Mrs. Gopman briefly updated Council on the Joint Financial Study agreed upon by Centerville and Washington Township that will analyze the possible financial impact if the two communities were to merge. She reported that the first round of interviews have been completed and she is compiling a list of community leaders from the City and the Township. The University of Toledo Urban Affairs Center/Wright State University are collecting information and will examine the financial impact of further cooperative efforts with regard to the two entities.

Mr. Horn explained that one visitor from Newry & Mourne, Ireland may not be able to come with regard to their scheduled visit for July 25 through July 28th. Both cities are possibly interested in establishing a Sister City relationship.
