Mr. Horn announced that with regard to Vectren's street closings (which include four different projects involving replacing some casings of a major gas transmission line). The following areas in the City will be affected. South Clyo Road to Spring Valley Road along St. Leonard's will be totally closed Monday, April 3 through Friday, April 7, 2006. They are bringing in a second crew to work on this project and this will take advantage of the spring break schedule. Work will also be done on Centerville Station Road just east of Clyo Road in front of St. Leonards; in the area of Stubb's Park on Spring Valley Road; and north of Revere Village Apartments on South Main, just south of Ashton Glenn Apartments.

Mr. Horn reported on the seasonal job fair that was held at Yankee Trace on Wednesday, March 15, 2006. There were 80 to 90 people in attendance. It is something the City may want to consider hosting with Washington Township and the Park District.

Mr. Singer inquired about the proposed access road behind the Woodbourne Library and McDonalds Restaurant. Discussion was held as to whether the Library Board had met with the Connor Group and if there is an interest on the Library's part to move forward with a preliminary engineering study.
