Mrs. Angella Tapogna was introduced to Council as the Project Manager for the implementation of Create the Vision. She explained where she previously lived and her prior work experiences.

Mr. Horn reviewed how the RETS Tech Center has grown through the years, since receiving an ED/GE Grant in 1998. It has exceeded the job creation requirement. The City has applied for a \$65,000.00 ED/GE Grant on behalf of RETS Tech Center. Jurisdiction funding was in the form of a Business Expansion Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00.

Mr. Horn advised that Fire Chief Kenneth Parks has asked for a date to hold a Grand Opening of the new fire house on Centerville Business Parkway. Mayor Kingseed suggested that it be held on a Monday evening before a Council Work Session, possibly on Monday June 13, 2005, to begin at 6:00 P.M.

Mr. Horn advised that a schedule for another five Neighborhood Improvements Meetings will be in Council packets on Friday, May 20, 2005. Three additional meetings to be held in 2005, and two in 2006.

Mr. Liberman explained that portion of House Bill 473 which relates to sex offenders. This Bill allows Cities to take civil action to force sexually oriented offenders to move if they live within 1,000 feet of a school. This will be an agenda item for the June 6, 2005 Work Session.
