Mr. Horn announced that the City should close on the property owned by the Pyper Construction Company located on South Suburban Road adjacent to the City's Public Works facility.

Mr. Horn advised that a preliminary report relative to waste collection will be ready for the Council Retreat.

Mr. Horn reported that Mr. Covell continues to work with representatives of Conner and Murphy Properties for the City's purchase of the connecting strip of land needed for the North Village Drive Access Road. He proposed that the City offer \$5,000.00 for this acquisition so that Conner and Murphy has something in writing to which to respond.
