

Mr. Horn advised that organizations have asked to advertise their events on the City's marquee at the entrance into the Leonard E. Stubbs Memorial Park. As a result of discussion as to limitations, Council concurred that the marquee only be used for City advertising, but that organizations using the park can erect their own sign.

Mr. Horn reported that a portion, if not all, of Walnut Hills, do not receive Channel 10 on cable television. He has been in contact with the Miami Valley Communications Council to correct this problem caused by Time Warner.
