Mr. Husemann outlined the challenges the City of Kettering faces with their Municipal Court. They currently experience space limitations, security problems, lack of jury rooms, inadequate parking spaces, lack of office space, inadequate rest rooms and the inability to satisfy ADA requirements. He outlined court costs received and how these monies are allocated. Mr. Husemann compared Kettering court costs with costs charged by other Municipal Courts in the area. Mr. Spaulding explained how the DESC facility can be renovated to accommodate the needs of the Kettering Municipal Court. Discussion followed relative to the distance between the DESC facility and the Centerville Police facility, the possibility of a satellite court, and the reestablishment of a Mayor's Court in Centerville.

Mr. Husemann advised that the Kettering City Council has passed a Resolution authorizing him to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Centerville and the Centerville-Washington Park District involving the Iron Horse Recreation Trail and the Kettering Recreation Trail.

Mr. Husemann reported that the Kettering City Council needs additional information relative to gas and electric aggregation before making a decision relative to placing the issues on the May election ballot.
