


Mr. Horn reported that Dan Sammon, the City's Assistant Building Inspector has been off work for the past several months for medical reasons. He will soon have used all his sick leave and vacation leave. Miss Gilleland provided four options for Council to consider relative to sick leave advancement. Council concurred that Mr. Horn be given the authority to approve up to one year advance of sick leave and vacation leave for this one instance (Up to 15 days sick leave and 18 days vacation leave).

Mr. Horn brought Council's attention to e-mails received from Madeline Breslin, member of the Peace Coalition of Dayton/Montgomery County, to encourage the passage of a Resolution in opposition to War on Iraq. Mayor Beals pointed out that it has been the policy of City Council to not take a stand on an issue as a whole. Individuals can do what they want. The majority of Council indicated no interest in this endeavor.

Mr. Horn advised that the Centerville-Washington Township Historical Society requested an additional contribution of \$2,500 out of the 2002 Budget to assist in the planning of celebrations for the 2003 centennial. This amount was overlooked when the contribution to the Society was given by the City of Centerville in 2002. As a result of discussion, Miss Gilleland will obtain additional information for Council's review.

Mr. Horn advised that he will contact the John Kalamán family relative to naming the roadway immediately east of the Municipal Building as Kalamán Way.
