Mrs. Pence explained the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Ohio EPA's Phase II Storm Water program. She outlined the program being developed for the City of Centerville and requirements set forth by the Storm Water Management Plan. The program will reduce the discharge of pollutants to the maximum extent practicable, to protect water quality, and to satisfy the appropriate requirements of the Clean Water Act.

Mr. Pozzuto outlined five key areas yet to be addressed in the proposed Agreement between the City of Centerville and Graeter's Ice Cream.
