Mr. Kingseed advised that a fund raising letter will be mailed soon by the War Memorial Committee. An additional \$65,000.00 is needed for phase one.

Mr. Krass moved that Council convene into Executive Session to discuss litigation and property acquisition. Mr. Kingseed seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.


Mr. Donald Eadie was interviewed by City Council for appointment as a member of the City Beautiful Commission. Council concurred with said appointment.



Discussion followed relative to the appointment of a Chairman for the Planning Commission. Mr. Cline will speak with Robert St. Pierre to seek his chairmanship.

Mr. Singer expressed concern with the delegation of authority to a staff member rather than the City Manager as provided in the Right-of-Way Ordinance recently passed by City Council and with the fact that an appeal would be filed in Common Pleas Court instead of City Council. Mr. Farquhar explained that the Ordinance could be changed to delegate the authority to the City Manager and that an appeal be filed with City Council. As a result of further discussion, Mr. Krass suggested that the Ordinance be left as written at the present time.

Discussion followed relative to available properties for the location of a new Public Works facility.
