AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 885.01, AUTHORITY TO LEVY TAX; PURPOSES OF **CENTERVILLE** TAX; RATE. OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN THE INCOME TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (0.50%) COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2017 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL **OPERATIONS** OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, it is City Council's determination that it is necessary to increase the municipal income tax rate by one-half of one percent (0.50%) from one and three-fourths percent (1.75%) to two and one-fourth percent (2.25%) to replace revenue lost through cuts by the State of Ohio and to secure the City's financial future; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to revise Chapter 885 of the Centerville Municipal Code to reflect this increase in taxes if approved by the electorate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 718.04, the City Council must submit this issue to the electorate of the City for approval or rejection.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subject to the approval of this Ordinance by the electors of the City, that the following amendment to Section 885.01(b) of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *italics* and text to be deleted in strikeout as provided in Section 5.02 of the Centerville Charter:

885.01(b) PURPOSE OF TAX; RATE.

For the purpose of providing funds for the purpose of general municipal operations, which includes *police*, maintenance, repair and upgrading of existing streets, new equipment, extension and enlargement of Municipal services and facilities and capital improvements of the city there is hereby levied a tax at the rate of 1.75% two and one-fourth percent (2.25%) per annum.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 885, EARNED INCOME TAX, OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville periodically reviews the laws relating to municipal income taxes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville Income Tax Division has recommended certain changes to the City's Municipal Code relating to municipal income taxes; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to amend Chapter 885 of the Centerville Municipal Code to incorporate these changes.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the following amendment to Centerville Municipal Code Section 885.05, is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *bold italics* and text to be deleted in strikeout as provided in section 5.02 of the Centerville Charter.

885.05 COLLECTION AT SOURCE.

- (a) Collection at source; withholding from qualifying wages.
 - (2) A. An employer, agent of an employer, or other payer shall remit to the deducted and withheld or the income taxes required to be deducted and withheld by the employer, agent, or other payer, along with any report required by the Tax Administrator to accompany such payment according to the following schedule:
 - i. Any employer, agent of an employer, or other payer not required to make payments under division (a)(2)A.ii. of this section of taxes required to be deducted and withheld shall make quarterly payments to the Tax Administrator not later than the fifteenth-last day of the

month following the end last day of each calendar quarter.

ii. Taxes required to be deducted and withheld shall be remitted monthly to the Tax Administrator if the total taxes deducted and withheld or required to be deducted and withheld by the employer, agent, or other payer on behalf of the municipal corporation in the preceding calendar year exceeded two thousand three hundred ninety-nine dollars, or if the total amount of taxes deducted and withheld or required to be deducted and withheld on behalf of the municipality in any month of the preceding calendar quarter exceeded two hundred dollars. Payments Payment—under division (a)(2)A.ii. of this section shall be made so that the payment—is-received by the to Tax Administrator not later than fifteen days after the last day of each month.

SECTION 2. That the following amendment to Centerville Municipal Code Section 885.09, is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *bold italics* and text to be deleted in strikeout as provided in section 5.02 of the Centerville Charter.

885.09 ANNUAL RETURN

(d) Extension of time to file.

(1) Any taxpayer that has duly requested an automatic sixmonth extension for filing the taxpayer's federal income tax return shall automatically receive an extension for the filing of a municipal income tax return. The extended due date of the municipal income tax return shall be the fifteenth day of the tenth month after the last day of the taxable year to which the return relates. The taxpayer shall attach a copy of said federal extension request to the municipal income tax return.

SECTION 3. That the following amendment to Centerville Municipal Code Section 885.10, is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *bold italics* and text to be deleted in strikeout as provided in section 5.02 of the Centerville Charter.

885.10 PENALTY, INTEREST, FEES AND CHARGES

(c) The municipality shall impose on a taxpayer, employer, any agent of the employer, and any other payer, and will attempt to collect, the interest amounts and penalties

prescribed in this section when the taxpayer, employer, any agent of the employer, or any other payer for any reason fails, in whole or in part, to make to the municipality timely and full payment or remittance of income tax, estimated income tax, or withholding tax or to file timely with the municipality any return required to be filed.

(5) All returned payments shall be subject to a \$25 service

fee.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
