

Prior to a Work Session being held, the Council Finance Committee of the Whole met to finish the review of the Capital Improvement Program for 2004-2008 and to begin review of the 2004 Budget for the City of Centerville.

Mr. Horn explained that Vectren is sending letters to customers who have signed up with Shell Energy for natural gas advising them that they will receive two bills, one from Shell Energy for the gas and one from Vectren for the delivery.
