Mrs. Lienesch reviewed the recent meeting held by the Centerville-Washington Diversity Council at which the success of the Martin Luther King, Jr. breakfast was highlighted.

Mayor Beals advised that the National League of Cities Annual Congressional Conference is being held in Washington, D.C. beginning March 8 through March 12, 2002.

Mr. Horn reviewed a proposed Resolution to authorize the City Manager to sell common stock issued by Anthem Insurance Companies, Inc. to the City of Centerville, in the amount that is determined to be in the best interest of the City.

Mr. Horn advised that legislation has been placed on the Council Meeting Agenda to provide for Special Assessment Financing (SAF VII) to complete remaining improvements in Yankee Trace.

Mr. Kingseed reviewed his meeting with Washington Township Fire Chief Ken Parks. Chief Parks expressed his support for Accreditation and his support for the development of an advisory board with representation from the City of Centerville. He is opposed to a Fire District.
