



Centerville City Council/Washington Township Trustees

The City presented questions to the Township and the Township submitted questions to the City relative to Finance, Township and City services, the current relationship between the two governments and the future for the entire community. Discussion followed relative to the questions to be answered and how the community's future should best be determined. It was the consensus of both entities that an accounting firm be hired as a consultant to study the economics of each entity and to prepare a detailed analysis in order for the two governments to consider the future which would best serve the residents of the Centerville Washington Township community. It was agreed that all members of City Council and the Washington Township Trustees must come together with an open mind. Trustee Terry Blair and Deputy-Mayor Mark Kingseed volunteered to serve on a committee along with City Manager Gregory Horn and Gary Huff to recommend a consultant to be used in this endeavor. It was recognized that the expertise will be necessary from time to time from other members of staff. It was further suggested that this consultant search take place within the next few weeks.
