Mr. Horn reviewed a proposed layout for the golf course expansion at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace and outlined some changes to be made.


Mr. Horn gave a health update for Public Works Director Steve Weaver.

Mr. Horn located on a map the 69.447 acre tract of land which is the subject of an annexation petition before the Montgomery County Commissioners and land being purchased by Washington Township for open space: 71.5 acres of land at \$34,000 per acre for a total of \$2,431,000. A condition of this purchase is that the annexation petition be withdrawn. Discussion followed relative to the City's reaction to the purchase of this land by Washington Township and the pending annexation petition.

Mr. Horn advised that a decision should be reached during the current week relative to whether or not the BUY.COM Golf Tournament will be played at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace.
