Mayor Beals explained to City Council that an Estate Tax Presentation before the Joint Committee on Estate and Death Taxes will be in Council packets on Friday, March 9, 2001. Finance Director Mark Schlagheck and City Manager Gregory Horn have been asked to supply an explanation of this document.

Mr. Feverston reviewed the request submitted by The Franciscan at St. Leonard for an extension of City Council's Master Plan approval granted on March 15, 1999.
