Mr. Horn outlined additional costs associated with furnishings in the new Centerville Police facility. The amount budgeted for these new furnishings is \$125,000.00. It now appears that the cost will be approximately \$240,000.00. Mr. Horn explained three options to be considered:

- 1. Purchase furnishings in the amount of \$125,000.00 and utilize old, perhaps outdated, furnishings.
- 2. Purchase furnishings in the amount of \$125,000.00 and sign a lease purchase agreement for a period of four years in the amount of \$115,000.00.
- 3. Sign a lease purchase agreement for a period of four or five years in the total amount of \$240,000.00 and use the budgeted \$125,000.00 for additional change orders.

Mr. Horn recommended option 2 and that Banc One Leasing Corporation be the funding authority.

Mr. Horn distributed to Council Memos prepared by the Centerville Police Department relative to speed board details on Zengel Drive. Theses reports were prepared in answer to a letter received from John Garner, 85 Zengel Drive, dated October 2, 2001. Lieutenant David Williams has met with Mr. Garner to discuss with him his complaint and speed findings on Zengel Drive. Mr. Horn will also meet with Mr. Garner to review these reports.

Mr. Horn advised that the solicitation for signatures is continuing for a Referendum to place Senate Bill 5 before the electorate in November, 2002.
